#### Does it tell a Story?

Can the reader determine the purpose of the scrapbook?

### Do you identify your Photos?

Do you identify your pictures as to who's in them, or what they're about?

# **Placement of Page Elements**

Does your scrapbook have a unified look; does it take the viewer on a journey?

### Does your scrapbook use Page Titles?

A page title can highlight or support the page theme or topic.

### Do you use "Journaling"?

Does it contain an assortment of articles, pictures, and information to make it a scrapbook and not just a photo album?

#### **Dressing Up with Embellishments**

Embellishments can enhance your page as interesting decorative pieces. If you want to add dimension, glitz or texture to your page, try adding on an embellishment or two.
