## **Is it Organized?**

## **Does it have a Common Theme?**

Is it about Your Camp as a whole, is it about the past year, or is it about a special event?

## **Does it tell a Story?**

Can the reader determine the purpose of the scrapbook?

## **Do you identify your Photos?**

Do you identify your pictures as to who's in them, or what they're about?

## **Placement of Page Elements**

Does your scrapbook have a unified look; does it take the viewer on a journey?

## **Does your scrapbook use Page Titles?**

A page title can highlight or support the page theme or topic.

## **Do you use "Journaling"?**

Does it contain an assortment of articles, pictures, and information to make it a scrapbook and not just a photo album?

## **Dressing Up with Embellishments**

Embellishments can enhance your page as interesting decorative pieces. If you want to add dimension, glitz or texture to your page, try adding on an embellishment or two.
