

Name: John Henry Wakefield

**Rank: Private** 

**Unit:** Co. I, 11th Texas Cavalry

Battles or interesting fact: Private Wakefield fought in Osage County, Indian Territory at Elkhorn Tavern and several other battles. He was wounded 31 December 1862 at Murfreesboro, Tennessee, and still went on to fight at Richmond, Kentucky and Perryville, Kentucky, numerous battles in Georgia including the defense of Atlanta. Private Wakefield was the last member of the 11th Texas Cavalry to surrender at the end of the war.

#### Cheryl Ayer's CSA ancestor.

Name: Demarcus C. Pettus

**Rank: Sergeant** 

**Unit:** Co. K, 7th Arkansas Infantry

<u>Battles or interesting fact</u>: SGT. Pettus was wounded at the Battle of Shiloh (Pittsburgh Landing) on 6 April 1862. He was wounded again in the Battle of Chickamauga, and then killed in the Battle of Franklin, Tennessee on 30 November 1864. He was 21 years old.

#### Sons of Confederate Veterans,

<u>September 26, 2024</u>: Williamson County Historical Commission will host speakers on Williamson County history at the Courthouse. Tickets available on-line.








The air is filled with suspense and excitement. Competitors, dressed in cowboy attire, stand poised with their hands hovering over their holstered revolvers. The sharp crack of the starting signal breaks the tension, and in a blur of motion, contestants draw, aim, and fire at their targets in fractions of a second. The sport of Cowboy Fast Draw is the largest organization devoted to the Sport of Fast Draw to ever exist. We use the best 1800's equipment available: Single action revolvers and center fire cartridges, shooting 45 long colt and wax bullets.. Our contests are elimination style. The loser of the bout receives an "X" and after 4 "X"s they are eliminated from the contest. Our clothing is western style, late 1800's period themed. We may not ever know a person's real name. (My alias is "Texas Tornado")

My Dad got me into the sport about 2-1/2 years ago. The CEO of Cowboy
Fast Draw is a long time friend and competition shooting compadre. So, I've
been shooting for just that long - 2-1/2 years. I've not yet won a
championship, but I have been in the Top 7 shoot offs, known as the
Magnificent 7, a total of 6 times. They say once you smell the gunsmoke, you
are hooked. And I was hooked after my first shot!

## CONFEDERATE ART & WRITING



The Lion of Atlanta by Billy Ayers

Beneath the whispering pines of Atlanta's Oakland Cemetery, the Lion of Atlanta stood for 130 years. Erected in 1894 by The Atlanta Ladies Memorial Association as a poignant reminder of the ultimate sacrifice made by the 3000 Confederate dead that it guarded. The monument, which is made up of 15 tons of Georgia marble depicts the Lion laying prostrate on top of a Confederate battle flag, ever loyal and defiant even in the face of defeat. The Lion was removed by the Atlanta City Council in 2021 leaving our soldiers graves unmarked. The Lion of Atlanta is reportedly being kept in safe storage after having been vandalized numerous times, unlike many Confederate monuments which have been toppled and destroyed by adherents of the democrat party. It is our fervent hope that sometime in the future this glorious monument to our noble ancestors can be resurrected in a place of honor.
